



**GM2010

Camp Infrastructure
Scope of Work**

Guiding Mosaic 2010 (GM2010) is Girl Guides of Canada's next national camp, and will be held July 8 – 17, 2010 at Guelph Lake Conservation Area in Southern Ontario.

The overall camp goals are as follows:

- To provide a camp that incorporates girl voice in planning and implementation
- To provide a camp that provides Rangers with leadership opportunities
- To provide a camp experience that retains Members and recruits new Members
- To provide a camp that provides equitable access for all applicants
- To provide a camp that creates media awareness of Girl Guides of Canada
- To provide a camp that is program based, not camping skills based

The National Camp Steering Committee has deemed the following overarching guidelines for GM2010:

- GM2010 will provide girls with the opportunity to participate in the planning and implementation of all aspects of this camp
- GM2010 will have an environmental consciousness and “go green” focus to all activities and services provided to participants.
- GM2010 will have an historical touch in activities for participants

Volunteer Opportunity – Food Service Crew Member

This position works with and supports the Marquee Food Service Coordinator, Food Services Delivery Sub Team Lead, Camp Infrastructure Team and Events Department (GGC) and together the team will work in a collaborative effort to ensure the delivery of camp is an efficient one. This position will be accountable to the Food Service Delivery Team Lead.

Key Responsibilities

As Food Service Crew Member for the Food Services Delivery Team, you and your team will be responsible for the delivery of all food services provided at the main dining facilities at GM2010 respecting the three overarching guidelines as listed above.



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As Food Service Crew Member for the Food Services Delivery Team, your key responsibilities will include the following:

- Assist camp participants with meal selections at the dining marquees in a helpful and efficient manner
- Communicate any camper concerns to Food Service Coordinators
- Deliver meals to those unable to access dining marquees during food service hours ie. shift workers in the wellness centre, security
- Pack and deliver mug up items to neighbourhoods
- Take inventory, deliver and restock locations throughout camp that supply food items ie., hospital, town square

Logistics:

Work within your team will be undertaken using technology ie. Phone, email, webex, with the occasional face to face meeting as necessary.

Working Relationship:

As a Food Service Crew Member you will work with the Food Service Coordinators, reporting to the Marquee Coordinator, to ensure the efficient execution of all food services to participants at GM2010.

Timeframe for Appointment:

This position will commence January 2010 and terminate August 31, 2010.
