Scope of Work**

Guiding Mosaic 2010 (GM2010) is Girl Guides of Canada's next national camp, and will be held July 8 – 17, 2010 at Guelph Lake Conservation Area in Southern Ontario.

The overall camp goals are as follows:

- To provide a camp that incorporates girl voice in planning and implementation
- To provide a camp that provides Rangers with leadership opportunities
- To provide a camp experience that retains Members and recruits new Members
- To provide a camp that provides equitable access for all applicants
- To provide a camp that creates media awareness of Girl Guides of Canada
- To provide a camp that is program based, not camping skills based

The National Camp Steering Committee has deemed the following overarching guidelines for GM2010:

- GM2010 will provide girls with the opportunity to participate in the planning and implementation of all aspects of this camp
- GM2010 will have an environmental consciousness and “go green” focus to all activities and services provided to participants.
- GM2010 will have an historical touch in activities for participants

Volunteer Opportunity – Health & Wellness: Staff

This position works with and supports the Health & Wellness Services Team, the Camp Infrastructure Team and the Department (GGC) and together the team will work in a collaborative effort to ensure the delivery of camp is an efficient one. - Provide first aid, either at the wellness centre (hospital) or at one of the first aid stations located throughout the camp site.
 - Follow Safe Guide
 - Work a combination of shifts during the day and/or night
 - Requirements:
 - You **MUST** have a valid St. John's First Aid Certificate or equivalent
 - Extra training as an LPN, an RN, a paramedic or other allied health professional is an asset but not a requirement.

Logistics:

Work within your team will be undertaken using technology ie. phone, email, webex with the occasional face to face meeting as necessary.

Working Relationship:

As a member of the Health and Wellness team, you will work closely with the Health & Wellness Team Leaders as well as your own team to ensure the efficient execution of health & wellness services to participants at GM2010. You will work with the Health & Wellness team to ensure that all deliverables are on time and within budget.

Timeframe for Appointment:

This position will commence June 2010 and terminate August 31, 2010.
